**Extracts from the minutes of the Airmyn Parish Council meeting held on Wednesday, 9<sup>th</sup> November, 2011.**

**A:** Former school house condition - RESOLVED that the council will wait until the deadline date of January 2012 to establish from ERYC the situation at that date and receive updates to all matters of concern.

**B:** Village entrance sign - RESOLVED that Cllr Peake will liaise with Alex Wells (ERYC) to see exactly what it is she requires and try to provide this to her, in order to move forward with the sign design.

**C:** Unadopted paths - RESOLVED to wait for further advice and updates from ERYC when they are available.

**D:** River bank styles - RESOLVED to await Cllr Jackson's report as he was absent from the meeting.

**E:** Tree survey - RESOLVED to check with ERYC that planning consent is not required for any of the works required before allowing Mr Bell to start the work.

**F:** Rusholme wind farm grant application - RESOLVED that the council will now support the Memorial Hall Committee in a new project to fund new acoustic walling in the hall to help reduce sound distortion.

**G:** Flooding/drainage problems - RESOLVED that in view of the high cost, it was decided to abandon the idea of the drainage board adoption of dykes. Cllr Fox will arrange a site inspection by ERYC to look at the blockages and advise.

**H:** Parking at White City - RESOLVED that the clerk now requests 'No overnight parking' signs be placed at the lay-by near Glews garage, towards White City and the lay-by before Boothferry Bridge as it has been noticed that HGVs regularly park there by day and night.

**I:** Clerk's annual salary and pension - RESOLVED that a proposal be made to the clerk, (which was later accepted), regarding her position on the salary scale. The clerk will now have a salary review and appraisal every February.

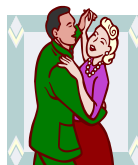
